

## Uniform

Due to a large amount of lost property accumulating each term, it is imperative that all items are clearly marked. At the end of each term, any unmarked items will be disposed of.

### General information for all Kindergarten to Year 6 students

<b>Hair</b>	To be clean and neatly groomed. Fringes to be above eyebrows or, if longer, pinned/kept back as to not cover the eyes. If hair is long enough, typically indicated by the hair touching the shirt collar, it must be tied back. No shaved heads nor obvious unnatural and two-tone colouring of hair. Accessories must be of School colours - solid red, blue or white only, not patterned. Excessively large accessories are not permitted. Boys will be clean shaven. (Final interpretation of acceptability of hair style rests with staff).
<b>Make-up</b>	None (including nail varnish).
<b>Jewellery</b>	A watch, plus up to two other pieces of plain jewellery, e.g. one pair of ear studs/sleepers plus necklace. Necklaces and bracelets must consist of a simple/thin silver or gold, not leather or other 'chunky' forms, with any ornaments small and inconspicuous. One pair of plain earrings must be sleeper or studs only, and worn only in the ear lobe. No other visible body piercings. In the case of smart watches, these will be treated more like a phone. Should they be a distraction or used inappropriately, they may be confiscated.
<b>School Bags</b>	St Stephen's school bags, back packs and sport bags from the uniform shop.
<b>Scarf</b>	St Stephen's scarf from the uniform shop. Optional only in winter.
<b>Hat</b>	St Stephen's broad-brimmed hat.

### Kindergarten to Year 2

This uniform is to be worn every day of School. Girls and boys have the same uniform.

<b>Shorts</b>	Navy blue sports shorts with SSS on leg.
<b>Shirt</b>	Blue, red and white striped polo with School crest.
<b>Socks</b>	White with red and blue stripes, sports style.
<b>Shoes</b>	Black sport style.
<b>Tracksuit</b>	St Stephen's tracksuit pants and jacket.

### Year 3-6 Girls

<b>Culottes</b>	Navy blue.
<b>Shirt</b>	White polo with School crest.
<b>Socks</b>	White, ankle-length. Navy blue stockings optional in winter.
<b>Shoes</b>	Black, lace-up, standard 'school style' shoes, clean and polished. Fashion, higher heeled shoes are not to be worn (heels more than 3 cm are not to be worn).
<b>Trousers</b>	Navy long trousers are optional in winter.
<b>Jumpers</b>	Red St Stephen's. Must fit appropriately, i.e. sleeves not worn over the hand, or jumper overstretched in any way. The tracksuit top is only to be worn with the sports uniform or the over school jumper for extra warmth.

### Year 3-6 Boys

<b>Shorts</b>	Navy blue.
<b>Shirt</b>	White polo with School crest.
<b>Socks</b>	3-6 St Stephen's short or long navy, with red and white stripes.
<b>Shoes</b>	Black, lace-up, standard 'school style' shoes, clean and polished.
<b>Trousers</b>	Navy long trousers are optional in winter.
<b>Jumpers</b>	Red St Stephen's. Must fit appropriately, i.e. sleeves not worn over the hand, or jumper overstretched in any way. The tracksuit top is only to be worn with the sports uniform or the over school jumper for extra warmth.

### Year 3-6 Sports

This is to be worn on days when Physical Education lessons are held, as well as on carnival days.

<b>Shorts</b>	St Stephen's navy blue sport shorts.
<b>Shirt</b>	House polo shirt. For inter-school events, the standard white polo shirt is worn.
<b>Socks</b>	White with red and navy stripes, sports style.
<b>Shoes</b>	Supportive sport shoe.
<b>Tracksuit</b>	St Stephen's tracksuit. This is optional. The formal red school jumper is not to be worn with the sports uniform.

### Non-Uniform Days

The final Monday of each term is a 'non-uniform' day. On this day, students may choose to not wear the school uniform, and contribute some pocket money to the Primary fundraising focus. On these days, students are still expected to dress appropriately (including shoulders covered, enclosed shoes), and the jewellery, hair and hat rules still apply.
