MyAICT Virtual Campus

Introducing AICT’s most exciting and innovative resource—MyAICT Virtual Campus! Students and teachers of our programs can now have access to their AICT classroom from anywhere at anytime.



This portal incorporates access to the Virtual PC – the Virtual PC allows students to undertake our program without any reconfiguring of school computer labs or purchasing of extra software licenses. Everything you need to undertake our program is already loaded on your Virtual PC desktop.

There are plenty of other useful resources including a cache of videos and documents, – our portal is designed so your school can go paper free! There is also access to online storage via a personalised SkyDrive and a trainer’s forum where teacher’s of our program from all high schools can post suggestions to one another and to our AICT trainer’s.

The portal allows for greater flexibility for self paced learners. Students can complete their work in the classroom or at home. They can submit their work and projects via the Portal. Their teachers can access their submitted work via their Portal login, and the dashboard feature provides an overview of all their student’s progress.

Accessibility: AICT’s Virtual Campus is equipped with accessibility options including the ability for all users to customise their backgrounds and font colours and sizes and an in-built text to audio screen reader.

Fees and Charges

- ✦ Upon receipt of all Student Enrolment forms AICT will issue an invoice to your school for the total annual cost to run our VETiS program in your school.
- ✦ Upon receipt of payment we will issue your receipt and update your training credits to your account.
- ✦ Due to the training credits program AICT does not refund fees collected for students that subsequently withdraw from the qualification.
- ✦ AICT provides moderation and support (up to three visits annually!) at no cost. Extra consulting services can be arranged as required and when required at a competitive hourly rate.

AICT Curriculum – Certificate II and III in Information, Digital Media and Technology

AICT’s unique curriculum incorporates both the Certificate II and III in Information, Digital Media and Technology helping your student’s to get ahead in their post secondary endeavours. Our course can be taken over one year (with reduced units in some cases) or spread over three years from year 10 and upward. Despite the layered curriculum some “switching off” of more advanced units is possible for student’s trying to complete just to the certificate II level in one year or for student’s with lesser learning abilities. Below is our indicative curriculum from 2014, NB curriculum and assessment tools are revised annually.

Project 1 — PC Build and Support

This project will teach you the fundamentals of computer hardware and architecture. You will learn how to build your own PC, install software, and configure an Operating System including basic system administration and troubleshooting.

Credit Transfers and Recognition of Prior Learning

Credit Transfer:

Only equivalent modules or units as shown in the current Training Package Purchasing Guide, or other published mapping document can be approved by AICT. Only a module that has been fully completed and in which a student has attained a pass mark in the form of being found 'competent' may be considered for Credit Transfer.

Granting Credit Transfer should be an administrative only process, where "like to like" units are approved. No fees apply for processing Credit Transfer applications. If an involved academic judgement or mapping process is required, a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) process must be undertaken instead.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

If you already have existing knowledge and skills relevant to your area of study, regardless of where or how they were acquired, you may get credit for this. Students should check with their teachers if they have previous study, work or life experience in the subject area they are undertaking or contact their AICT high school consultant for more information on applying for RPL.

Responsibilities

AICT's Responsibilities:

It is our duty to ensure that your teaching staff are qualified to deliver the qualification / units of competency in compliance with the requirements of the Australian Quality Training Framework (AQTF). AICT will also ensure quality of training by conducting regular moderation.

Host School's Responsibilities:

The school will ensure that the Student Enrolment Forms and Student Statistical Data are completed and returned to AICT by the mutually agreed date. The school must also report any student withdrawals from the AICT VETiS program within one week of student's withdrawal.

Student's Responsibilities:

Students of the AICT VETiS program are required to:

- ✦ Attend class
- ✦ Complete all assessment tasks
- ✦ Consult with their teacher as required

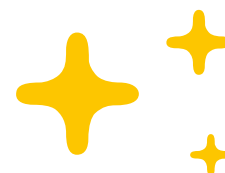
Naveen F.
