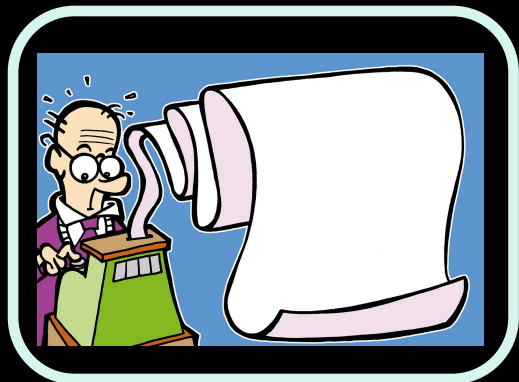

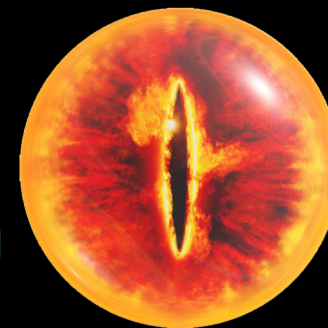
Exactly what are we getting ourselves into...

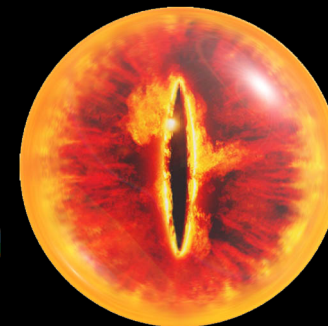
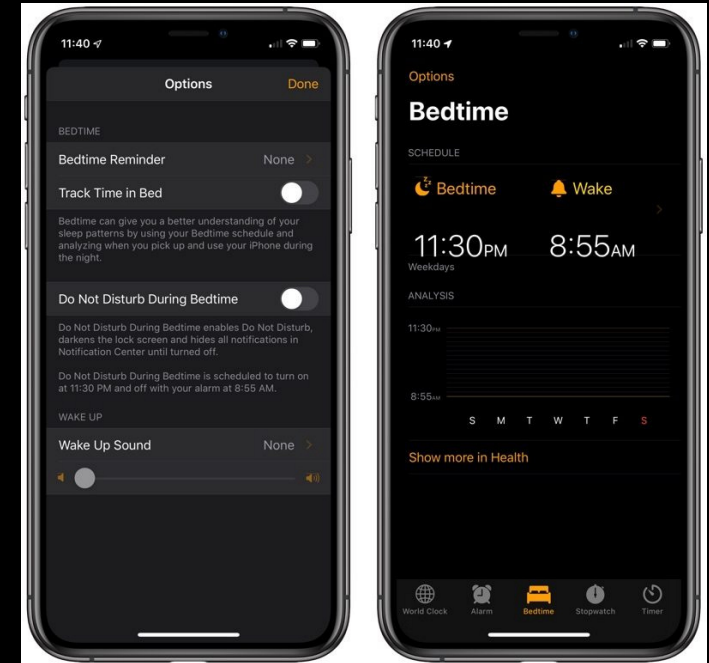
APPLE IOS 13

- Good for most older devices too

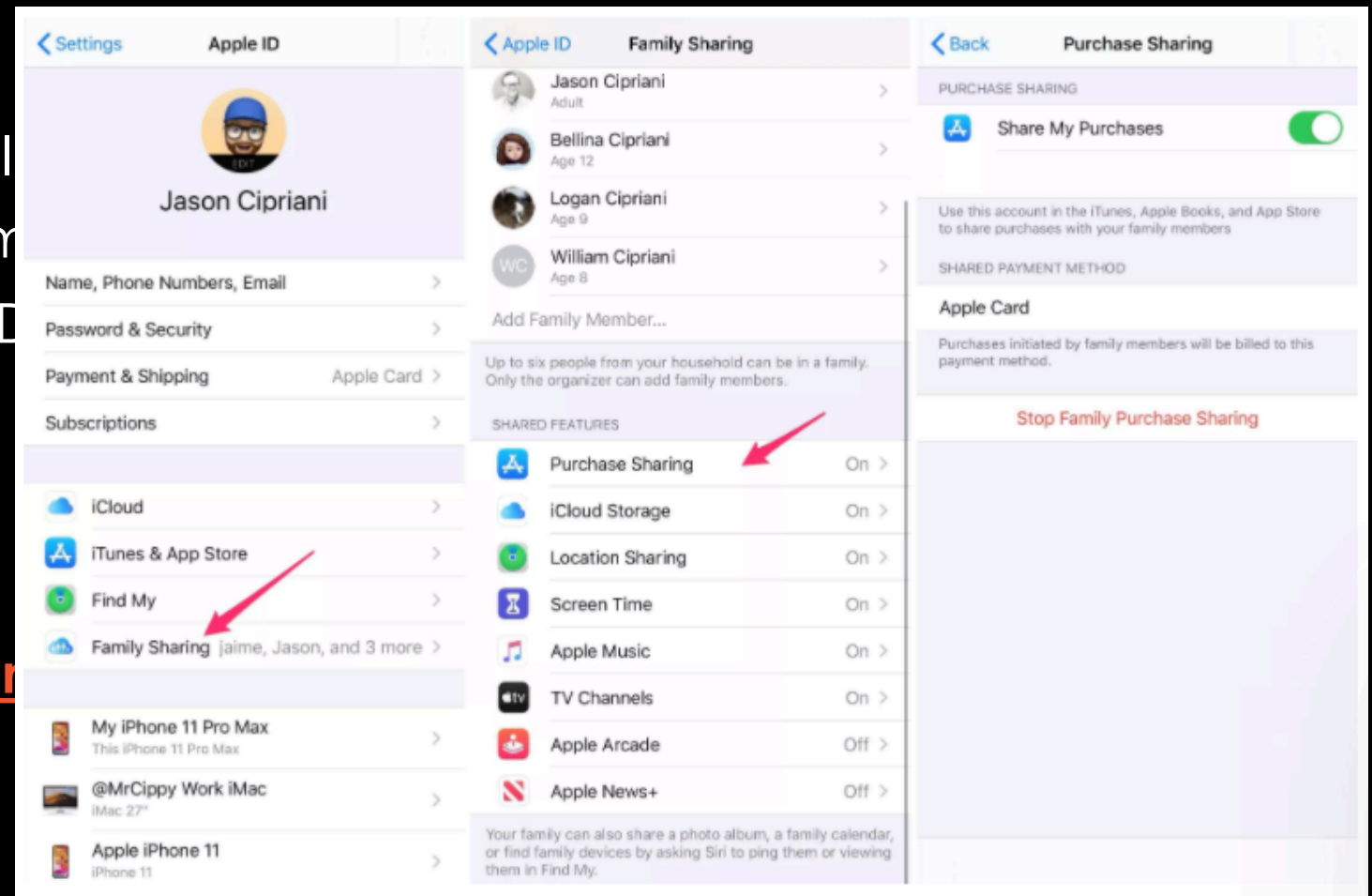
Capable Devices

FAMILY SHARING / MULTIPLE ACCOUNTS

- Buy ONCE use MANY
- Family sharing covers up to 5 people
- Purchase Sharing – one payment method
- This DOESN'T HAVE TO INCLUDE
 - iMessage
 - FaceTime
 - Email
- Can someone else in your family



DEFINE BOUNDARIES

Kids Need Boundaries

- Group chats using a wide range of apps
- Anytime of day – can affect sleep and mood

Clearly Defined Rules

- Central charging zone – such as parents bedroom, or other public area
- Pick up in morning – e.g. not before 07:30
- Drop off in evening – e.g. no later than 19:45
- Weekday / Weekend / School Holidays

TECHNOLOGY USE CONTRACT

CHILD EXPECTATIONS:

1. I will not share any personal information, including date of birth, name, address, phone number or specifics about what school I attend. I recognize that sharing such information could lead to harm if it gets in the hands of someone who intends to hurt me. I fully recognize the threat this is to my safety.
2. In all of my online communications, I will be respectful of others and will never embarrass, humiliate, threaten or bully anyone. My communications will always be truthful, encouraging and helpful.
3. I will never use vulgar or sexually explicit language, and if someone begins using such language with me, I will immediately refuse further communication.
4. I recognize there is no such thing as real privacy when on the Internet. I understand any content I post about myself or anyone else on the Internet can be distributed across the world without my knowledge or permission. Even if I intend such communication to be private, I have no guarantee that will be the case.
5. I understand that while I am communicating with persons whom I don't know, they are able to deceive me and may not be truthful about who they are and their intentions.
6. I will not post information on any of the social networking website such as MySpace, YouTube, Facebook, etc. without first discussing it with you and getting your permission.
7. I have earned your trust by obeying you as my parent(s) and I have every intention of continuing to do so. I willingly enter this agreement to be held accountable to you. By following these principles, we have agreed I will continue to enjoy the privilege of using Internet technology.

1. I will respect my child's privacy when he/she is using the Internet or other technology.
2. If I have a concern, I have the right to access their online accounts and/or website logs.

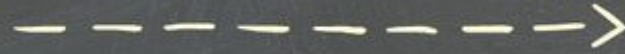

Screen Time Rules



- 1 Screen time includes television, gaming, phone and social media, computer. It does not include watching the **NEWS** or sitting down with the **FAMILY** to watch a movie on TV or at the cinema - these can be important **SHARING** times.
- 2 Screen time is limited to a maximum of **2 HOURS** a day. This must include any screen time that involves homework or projects. It does not include screen time for school activities **AT SCHOOL**.
- 3 Screen time required for homework **MUST** be completed before any leisure screen time can take place - you can't play Pokemon until that project on The Battle of Stirling Bridge is finished.
- 4 Screen time must be **TIMED**. It doesn't have to all be used up in one block; it can be spread out over the day (say at weekends), but it must be timed.
- 5 If you cannot **RELIABLY** clock your own screen time, then I will do it for you - and I will be **MUCH MORE** accurate than you are (just saying)!
- 6 You can **CHOOSE** one day a week as "free-for-all" day where there are no time limits to screen time...except that my **EXPECTATION** is that you will find a way to balance screen time with off-screen time.
- 7 In school holidays you can **WORK** for extra screen time. Jobs (outside of usual chores) completed around the house can **EARN** up to an extra hour of screen time a day that can be banked for use later on.
- 8 The screen time rules of this house do not apply to **FRIEND'S** houses - you live by their rules when in their house. **BUT**, your friends must follow the screen-time rules of this house while here.
- 9 I reserve the right to mix things up and offer a spontaneous "free-for-all" day - usually in response to some **EXCEPTIONAL** achievement or behaviour.
- 10 "Free-for-all" days only **BEGIN** when you have had breakfast, brushed your teeth and showered, got dressed and made your bed (and, ideally, made a **COFFEE** for your mother).

I understand that the use of technology is a privilege, not a right. I understand that my parent(s) has/have a right to regulate my use of technology within the home, regardless of who bought the device. I also understand that if I fail to respect the following rules, I will be subject to consequences, which may include losing access to this technology. With this understanding in place, I agree that:

All technology will be shut off (and turned in to my parent(s), if applicable) by _____ on weeknights, and _____ on weekends.

My parent(s) will have my password(s) in order to access and monitor my activity on all devices I use to ensure my safety. It is my responsibility to keep my parent(s) updated with my current password(s).

I will not use profanity, sexually explicit language, or any other inappropriate language as defined by my parent(s).

I will not send, share or otherwise transmit pictures of myself or anyone else which I would be embarrassed if my parent(s) or other trusted adult were to see them on my phone. If someone sends me a photo meeting this description, I will tell my parents immediately with the understanding that I will not get in trouble.

My parent(s) can and will monitor all use of technology within the house, and are able to access my accounts and devices at any time.

If someone is being mean or inappropriate to me or someone else while I am using technology, I will not respond and then I will tell my parents immediately with the understanding that I will not get in trouble.

I will follow the privacy settings determined by my parent(s), and will not communicate with anyone I do not know. If someone contacts me who is not approved or I do not know, I will talk with my parent(s) before communicating with that person.

I will not publicly post any of my personal information. Personal information includes, and is not limited to: my last name, address, phone number, name of my school and/or information about my family members.

I will check with my parent(s) before downloading any software or apps.

I will not lie about my age in order to access apps or websites.

Until I am ___ years old and/or my parent(s) approve it beforehand, I am allowed to play only video games and/or mobile game apps with a rating of: ___E ___E10+ ___T ___M

If my device is broken, damaged or lost, it is my responsibility to replace it.

This agreement is in place for my own well-being and safety.
