When buying a device for your child please note the following:

- o The Many2One "Bring Your Own Device" program runs from Years 5 to 12. At Year 5 it is a requirement that students provide their own device whilst still having access to primary school owned student shared devices. All Years 5 to 12 students are expected to bring their own mobile device to school from the commencement of the school year.
- o We are a "Bring Your Own Device" School. By the time students are in Years 7 it is a requirement that students provide a MacBook, Windows flip style notebook or a Windows notebook/tablet hybrid. These decisions are often shaped by the subjects the students are studying and the type of device they might use beyond school.
- o The class teacher will recommend any applications that need to be purchased specifically. All students are given a Microsoft Office 365 subscription which includes the Office Suite for up to 5 devices (Windows, Mac, iPad), Office online and 1024 GB of cloud storage.

# Screen Time Rules

- Screen time includes television, gaming, phone and social media, computer. It does not include watching the **NEWS** or sitting down with the **FAMILY** to watch a movie on TV or at the cinema these can be important **SHARING** times.
- Screen time is limited to a maximum of 2 HOURS a day. This must include any screen time that involves homework or projects. It does not include screen time for school activities AT SCHOOL
- Screen time required for homework MUST be completed before any leisure screen time can take place - you can't play Pokemon until that project on The Battle of Stirling Bridge is finished.
- 4 Screen time must be TIMED. It doesn't have to all be used up in one block; it can be spread out over the day (say at weekends), but it must be timed.
- f lf you cannot RELIABLY clock your own screen time, then I will do it for you and I will be MUCH MORE accurate than you are (just saying)!
- You can CHOOSE one day a week as "free-for-all" day where there are no time limits to screen time...except that my EXPECTATION is that you will find a way to balance screen time with off-screen time.
- In school holidays you can WORK for extra screen time. Jobs (outside of usual chores) completed around the house can EARN up to an extra hour of screen time a day that can be banked for use later on.
- The screen time rules of this house do not apply to FRIEND'S houses you live by their rules when in their house. BUT, your friends must follow the screen-time rules of this house while here.
- I reserve the right to mix things up and offer a spontaneous "free-for-all" day usually in response to some EXCEPTIONAL achievement or behaviour.
- "Free-for-all" days only BEGIN when you have had breakfast, brushed your teeth and showered, got dressed and made your bed (and, ideally, made a COFFEE for your mother).
